<u>WARNING</u>: The overall objective of the service hour program is to affirm service. To help students select service hours projects there is a list of pre-approved service hour projects. The list of pre-approved projects is not exhaustive, meaning that other service hour projects may be done; however, any service hour project that is not on the Pre-Approved List **may be rejected** if the service project does not fit within the approval guidelines established by the service hours program. If you would like to do a service project that is not on the pre-approved list, please submit the Request for Service Hours Approval Form to the Campus Ministry Service Hour Coordinator.

A Project List – 100 Points Per Hour (Projects that include person-to-person contact, training and preparation, and long-term commitment – weekly or monthly.)

B Project List – 75 Points Per Hour (Projects that include person-to-person contact and are short-term commitments – one to three days. Or projects that do not include person-to-person contact but are long-term commitments – weekly or monthly.)

- 4. Thrift Shop

C Project List -- 25 Points per Hour:

NOTE: This is not an exhaustive list. Any project not on the approved list must get prior approval to be used for service hours.
